

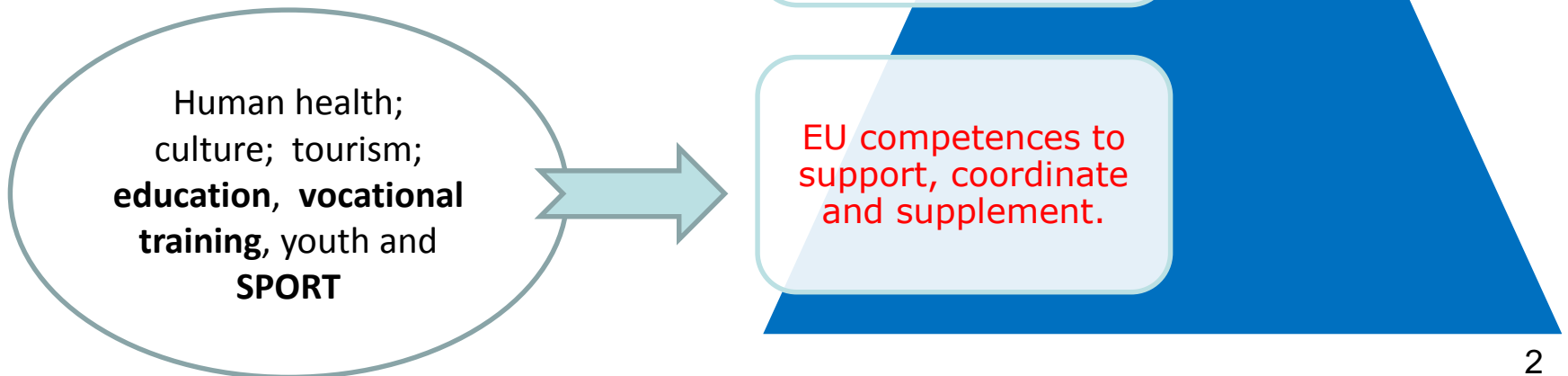

EU Work Plan for Sport 2017–2020

- 3 Priorities:**
- Integrity of sport
 - Economic dimension of sport
 - Sport and society

2 Expert Groups:

- Integrity

(good governance / anti-corruption / match fixing)

- Skills and human resources development in sport



EU Work Plan for Sport 2017–2020

Cluster meetings, conferences, seminars, studies:

4-5 December 2018: cluster meeting on integrity in sport

2018 Mapping study on corruption in sport

2019 (tbc) Recommendations on possible future actions against corruption in sport at the EU level (FI Presidency)

Erasmus+: Sport

- First-time funding for sport and physical activity projects
- Duration: **7 years (2014-2020)**
- Total budget for Sport: EUR **265.9 m**
- Budget for 2018: EUR **37.4 m**
